

What is FCA Certified Previous Daily Rental (CPDR)?

It is a unique certification program for low meterage, late model FCA previous daily rentals that have passed rigorous return criteria. These criteria are so stringent that meeting them qualifies a vehicle to receive a CARPROOF Top Condition™ badge.

To qualify to be a FCA Certified Previous Daily Rental (CPDR) these vehicles must have:

- ▶ A current CARPROOF Vehicle History Report
- ▶ Under \$1,000 in declared prior accident damage
- ▶ Less than the \$300 threshold in exterior wear*
- ▶ Clean interior and exterior
- ▶ No outstanding Mechanical or Operational issues
- ▶ Maintenance performed to exceed, or at the very least meet, Factory Guidelines
- ▶ Genuine Mopar Replacement parts used in repairs**
- ▶ No open safety or emission recalls
- ▶ No alterations to factory equipment

CarProof* Recognizes our quality standards and were more than willing to add Top Condition badges to our qualifying CPDR units.

- ▶ Along with this badge comes the FCA Certified Previous Daily Rental Title right in the CarProof Report.
- ▶ A brief explanation is also added:

“Did you know? An FCA Certified Previous Daily Rental vehicle has exceeded strict maintenance and condition requirements to be considered Top Condition”

The way it works:

- ▶ When VIN passed to CP, VHR Report Summary will display a Top Condition™ badge and FCA CPDR description will be added
- ▶ Badge remains until unit is retailed or 180 days after wholesale date, whichever is less
- ▶ Once unit is retailed, the badge drops off, but previous use remains
- ▶ A permanent record is then added to Condition History section
